California Fire Code

The California Code of Regulations Title 24 rulemaking continues. The BFO (building, fire and other) Code Advisory Committee, which reviews and makes recommendations to the proposed changes to the building, fire and other codes, met on August 14, 2012. The Preliminary Notice of Proposed Action (NOPA), Initial Statement of Reasons (ISOR), and Express Terms (ET) may be viewed on the California State Building Standards Commission (CBSC) website at <http://www.bsc.ca.gov/codes/adoptcycle/2012Cycle/2012CAC.aspx>. The 45-day public comment period for the proposed changes to the fire code is from August 31 to October 25. All comments for the proposed changes to the fire code must be submitted to the commission no later than close of business, October 15, 2012.
