People v. Pilot Travel Centers LLC
Reimbursement of Costs of Investigation and Enforcement
Paragraph 3.3.

Pilot shall pay \$25,000 by a company check made payable to “County of Los Angeles Department of Public Works.” The check shall bear on its face the case name (“*People v. Pilot*”), the Superior Court docket number, and the notation “Costs.”

Pilot shall pay \$25,000 by a company check made payable to “Riverside County Department of Environmental Health Hazardous Materials Division” (or “Riverside County DEH HAZMAT”). The check shall bear on its face the case name (“*People v. Pilot*”), the Superior Court docket number, and the notation “Costs.”

Pilot shall pay \$55,000 by a company check made payable to “California Department of Justice.” The check shall bear on its face the case name (“*People v. Pilot*”), the Superior Court docket number, the Attorney General’s internal docket number for this matter (“SA2005900432”), and the notation “Fees and Costs.” The monies shall be placed into a Litigation Deposit Fund account and used for purposes consistent with that account.

Pilot shall pay \$30,000 by a company check made payable to “Office of the District Attorney, County of Los Angeles.” The check shall bear on its face the case name (“*People v. Pilot*”), the Superior Court docket number, and the notation “Fees and Costs.”

Pilot shall pay \$30,000 by a company check made payable to “Office of the District Attorney, County of Monterey.” The check shall bear on its face the case name (“*People v. Pilot*”), the Superior Court docket number, and the notation “Fees and Costs.”
