Toxic Release Inventory (TRI) Program Deadline

July 1, 2013, is the deadline for reporting to the TRI for the 2012 calendar year. If you know a facility that is required to report to the TRI, please help spread the word. A facility must report to TRI if it:

- Is in a specific [industrial sector](#) (e.g., manufacturing, mining, electric power generation),
- Employs 10 or more full-time equivalent employees, and
- Manufactures, processes, or otherwise uses above threshold amounts of a [TRI-listed chemical](#) in a given year.
